

### Game Instructions:

Based on Chutes and Ladders, this game takes players across Belle Isle to discover how invasive species are impacting the environment and what players can do to prevent their spread. Start by picking a character card. These characters are native animals affected by invasive species. The color on the character card matches a pawn, which will be that character's playing piece on the board. Taking turns, each player rolls a die/ or uses an [online spinner](#) to determine how many spaces to advance. In this game, chutes represent the negative impacts of invasive species, and ladders represent ways people can restore the natural environment and stop their spread. At the end of a move, if a player lands at the bottom of a ladder they climb it and advance up the board. If a player lands at the top of a chute they slide down and land on a space already passed. Next turn, the player will start at that space they landed. Note: not all turns may result in landing on a chute or a ladder.

### Print Instructions:

**Option 1:** Download and print these PDFs to play at home! Cut out the player cards, pawns, and assemble the dice to play with up to 4 people.

**Option 2:** If you're looking for an eco-conscious option or without a printer, fear not! Open the PDF on a tablet, use some coins or small objects as pawns to play on the tablet, and use an online dice or spinner!
