Fish like me have been around since well before the dinosaurs. I am also known as a dragon fish.



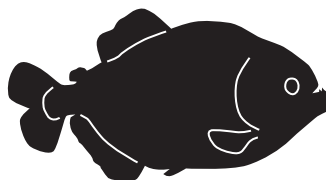
I eat of the bottom of the Amazon River and I have a spine on my tail.



I come from Africa and I am unique in that I can bury myself in the mud during the dry season. I can also breathe air above the water's surface.



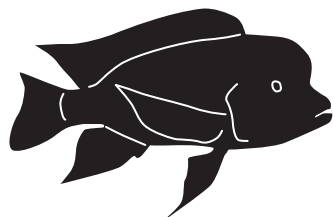
I am named after a feline and I change colors according to my mood.
